


How to View Recorded Presentations and Download Slides


These instructions are for **registered** attendees of the 2023 Scientific Sessions.

Step 1. Click this link to log into the web app: [2023 Scientific Sessions \(confex.com\)](https://2023scientificsessions.confex.com).




